

ACPS Code of Ethics

Approved by the ACPS board, November 9, 2017

Members shall:

1. Practice chemistry in accordance with the laws of Canada and Saskatchewan
2. Act in a manner which protects the health, safety and welfare of the public
3. Act in an honest, diligent manner.
4. Offer services, advice or undertake assignments only in areas of their competence.
5. Act in an objective and faithful manner as professional agents of the profession.
6. Present themselves in a professional manner providing a good image to the public.
7. Maintain confidentiality and avoid conflicts of interest.
8. Maintain a level of professional development in order to maintain competence, advance the body of knowledge, and provide opportunities for professional development for other members.
9. Cooperate with other agencies and professional organizations to ensure public welfare is protected.
10. Set fees which represent a fair pricing for goods and services provided
11. Build and support the reputation of the professional organization and the practice of chemistry.
12. Conduct themselves in a professional manner, and not deliberately or maliciously attempt to belittle or damage the reputation of another member of this or any other professional organization.
